7:30 - 8:30 a.m.	Registration for racers, coaches and race volunteers in the Harriman A-frame
8:00 a.m.	Team Captains Meeting in front of the A-Frame
8:00 a.m.	Lifts Open
8:15 a.m.	Gate Judges Meeting in the Harriman A-Frame
8:15 a.m.	Begin Course Inspection
9:00 a.m.	Top of Course closes
9:15 a.m.	Inspection Ends. Forerunners prepare to <i>start</i> Race Officials and Gatekeepers on Station
9:20 a.m.	Forerunners Begin
9:30 a.m.	First Run on Odyssey

Second run begins approximately one hour and fifteen minutes after end of 1st run.

Jr. III Cup West: Start order will be randomized; second run order will be the reverse of the first run. Ladies will run first, followed by men for both runs. Racers entering late will run last both runs.

Awards will be approximately 30 minutes after the finish of the second run in the A-frame.

Parent tickets will be on sale in the registration area in the A-frame for \$44.00, payable by check, cash (possibly by Credit Card if internet is working). We only have a limited number at this price.

Information and Rules

1. The race hill is closed during both runs. Viewing is allowed above headwall in trail opening from Iliad behind nets, at the road on skiers right, behind the netting at the Slalom finish, & at the Finish, NOT AT THE TOP OF THE HEADWALL! All clothing must go down another trail. Slip crews will be controlled by our chief of course at the Start. No movement on the race trail during race, except organized course maintenance during “start stop”. Course workers, coaches, and volunteers should avoid the finish line and timing beams.
2. All racers competing in Jr. III Cup West must have current NYSSRA (or other state) and USSA membership. Non-NYSSRA members must have NYSSRA permission to race.
3. All racers must conduct themselves in an appropriate manner. Unsportsmanlike conduct, obscene language or disrespect to race personnel, Greek Peak Mountain staff or other skiers will result in sanction. Illegal acts will be prosecuted fully by Law enforcement personal. DO NOT EXPECT YOUR BIB TO GET YOU ON THE LIFT! HAVE YOUR TICKET. Boarding the lift without a lift ticket is a crime. Don’t ruin your day and ours by getting ARRESTED for “theft of services.”
4. Ski brakes must be on and functional at all times.
5. Bibs must be worn at all times, particularly at start and while on course. Your bib will be collected in the finish area at the end of the second run. Lost bib, not returned bib - \$35 fee.
6. You must have a lift ticket to get on lift. Suggest sticking it to inside of speed suit by collar or a ticket wicket on a neck lanyard. There will be no special lift line privileges for racers.
7. Racers may inspect the course by climbing or side slipping it *without skiing or snowplowing through the gates*. Course inspection will commence at 8:15 AM. The course will be closed for access at 9:00 AM and cleared by course officials for the first forerunner at 9:15AM. No movement is allowed on the race hill once the race has started. Any movement will be allowed through organized slip only, which will be initiated by Chief of Course during a “start stop”.
8. In the event of interference on the course, the racer must immediately leave the course, STOP, notify the nearest Gate judge and proceed to the nearest Race Official with a radio – usually the Finish Referee – to request a provisional rerun. Do not complete the run. If a ski comes off less than two gates from the finish, you may finish, but must exit the finish area with all of your equipment.
9. DSQ's will be posted immediately following each run on the notice board on the scoreboard. A racer has 15 minutes from that time to make a formal protest. The protest must be in writing. Protests may be filed at the finish *timing building*. Fee \$50.
10. All FIS, USSA and NYSSRA rules are in effect.
